

AIEGL Prizes in Greek and Latin Epigraphy

Two *AIEGL* prizes (to be advertised every five years), one of which will be awarded for a work in the field of Greek epigraphy, the other for a work in the field of Latin epigraphy, consist of 2.500 Euro each and are reserved to works almost ready for publication but not published yet. The works may consist in a *corpus* of inscriptions or in a study essentially concerned with epigraphic material; the prizes are intended to support young researchers and therefore authors must be under age of 40 when they submit their works.

together with a letter of recommendation by a member of *AIEGL* and a letter of acceptance written by the editor of a scientific series or from a publishing house.

The Bureau has appointed a Committee of specialists, the so-called *Illviri*, who will examine the works and will appoint the winners; the prizes will be awarded during the meeting of *AIEGL* which will be held in Vienna on September 1st, 2017; the works, once published, should acknowledge the financial support of *AIEGL*.
